Read Letter No.201/Proj/DGR/KEXCON dated, 28.03.2025 of the Managing Director of KEXCON.

ORDER

The Managing Director, Kexcon in his letter read above has reported that all Central Government Public Sector Undertakings/Enterprises (CPSU/CPSEs) can take security cover from Security Agencies sponsored by Directorate General Resettlement (DGR), an attached office of the Ex-Servicemen Welfare Department under Ministry of Defence. Though KEXCON was empaneled with DGR as Security Agency during 2013 the empanelment provision of KEXCON was taken by DGR with an observation that "Security Services are not included in the MoA of KEXCON". For the re-entry of KEXCON into the DGR empanelment, the Managing Director of KEXCON reported that KEXCON requires to modify the Memorandum of Association with inclusion of the scope of job that is "Employment of ESM in security related assignments and guard duties".

2. The Managing Director KEXCON has reported that if KEXCON is get empaneled with DGR the security services of central

Government institutions in Kerala like GAIL, Oil Companies, FCI etc, which are being controlled and allotted through the DGR can be further allotted to KEXCON and this in turn ensure more job opportunities for ESM in our State. In the above circumstances, the Board of Directors of KEXCON in the meeting held on 22.03.2025 approved the inclusion of Security related assignment and guard duties in the Memorandum of Association of KEXCON, as Clause 43 to 47 after Clause 42 in Section III B in the MoA.

3. The Managing Director, KEXCON has proposed to amend the Memorandum of Association of KEXCON by inserting the following clauses after Clause 42 in Section III B of the Memorandum of Association of KEXCON, as decided by the Board of Directors of KEXCON .

(43) to provide security services on contractual basis on the following principles: -

- (a) Whenever the Government or semi-govt organizations or establishments, undertakings, corporations, boards, municipal corporations/councils, autonomous bodies, cooperative societies, Government medical colleges and hospitals, educational institutes, offices, Centre/State public sector undertakings, private establishments etc. require security services, they will requisition the same from the Corporation, which will provide Ex-Servicemen and their trained wards with no intention to distribute the surplus, if any, by way of dividend or otherwise.
- (b) The Corporation being a Government entity, tendering process shall not be adopted to requisition the security services from the Corporation with no intention to distribute the surplus, if any, by way of dividend or otherwise.
- (c) The Corporation shall provide technical consultancy for integrated security including installation of technical/electronic devices and security manpower by carrying out security audits of all such

undertakings, establishments or institutions, on the matters of security at their request, on payment of charges as may be specified by the Corporation with no intention to distribute the surplus, if any, by way of dividend or otherwise.

- (d) The Corporation may also provide security services and consultancy to the private sector undertakings and public sector undertakings, as and when requisitioned by them with no intention to distribute the surplus, if any, by way of dividend or otherwise.
- (e) If any weapon/arms ammunition are provided to any Ex-Serviceman security guard in the capacity of a Retainer by the Principal Employer or Corporation for protection of the men and materials of the Principal Employer, he shall *have* the right to use it for the said purpose as part of his duty, as per provisions contained in Rule 13 of the Arms Rule, 1962 with no intention to distribute the surplus, if any, by way of dividend or otherwise.
- (f) The Corporation may appoint such persons as Supervisors who possess prescribed qualifications for the purpose of this Act. A Supervisor may, subject to any rules made by the State Government, enter and search at all reasonable hours, any premise or place where Security Guards are employed for the purpose of examining any register, record of wages and the security arrangement with no intention to distribute the surplus, if any, by way of dividend or otherwise.

(44) to establish training institutes for computer training, career development training, pre-recruitment training, security training and skill development training in all disciplines with no intention to distribute the surplus, if any, by way of dividend or otherwise.

(45) to establish tourism industry with special emphasis on “military tourism”, which will be managed by Ex-Servicemen. It will focus on the youth/students to acquaint them with the various types of military installations and activities to motivate them to join Armed Forces. Besides, the project shall search at all reasonable hours, any premise or place where Security Guards are employed for the purpose of examining any register, record of wages and the security arrangement with no intention to distribute the surplus, if any, by way of dividend or

otherwise.

(46). to provide manpower other than security services to Ex-Servicemen and their wards, who are technically qualified for other categories like drivers, clerks, data operators, mechanics, electricians, masons, plumbers, wiremen, linemen, carpenter or any other category with no intention to distribute the surplus, if any, by way of dividend or otherwise.

(47). to undertake any other activities that may facilitate the re-settlement of Ex-Servicemen and their dependents with no intention to distribute the surplus, if any, by way of dividend or otherwise.

4. Government have examined the matter in detail and are pleased to amend the Memorandum of Association of KEXCON by inserting the afore said clauses 43, 44, 45, 46 and 47 after Clause 42 in Section III B.
