ORDER

As per the letter read 1st paper above, the Ministry of Environment, Forests & Climate Change, Government of India has issued an Advisory to deal with Human Wildlife Conflicts as per the recommendation of the Standing Committee of the National Board for Wildlife on its 60th meeting held on 5.01.2021. One of the management measures proposed in the Advisory is to constitute Inter-Departmental Coordination Committees at State Level and District Level for the prevention and management of Human Wildlife Conflict and associated death/killing of wild animals and for ensuring close coordination between Government Departments.

- 2. The Principal Chief Conservator of Forests (WL) & Chief Wildlife Warden, Kerala has submitted proposal as per letter read as 2 nd paper above for the constitution of State Level Coordination Committee and District Level Coordination Committee to deal with Human Wildlife Conflict.
- 3. Government have examined the matter in detail and are pleased to constitute Inter Departmental State Level Coordination Committee (SLCC) and District Level Coordination Committee (DLCC) to deal with Human Wildlife Conflict in the State of Kerala as detailed below.

The Officers included as the Divisional Forest Officer/Wildlife Warden of District Headquarters are given in Annexure to this Government Order.

The District Level Coordinate Committees are constituted in all 14 districts in the State as detailed above.

Functions of SLCC

- 1. With respect to managing the Human Wildlife Conflict, to review the required infrastructure, manpower and monitoring systems in the State and to take necessary measures to strengthen the same
- 2. Monitor the number of Human-Wildlife Conflict cases and their geographical spread, and provide guidance/instructions to different departments for action to be taken by each one of them in order to minimize/prevent Human-Wildlife Conflict in those areas
- 3. Review the quantum of ex-gratia relief, issue guidance / instructions for expedited payments, and work towards providing adequate funds for the same
 - 4. Review the cases for revenge killings of wild animals and other wildlife

related crime, and issue necessary guidance / instructions to the concerned departments / agencies as appropriate

5. Recommend to State Board for Wildlife and / or the Government, policy and programmatic measures, including for capacity building, required for fulfilling the objectives of the advisory read as 1st paper above.

The State Level Coordination Committee (SLCC) shall meet as many times as necessary, but no later than six months of the previous meeting.

Functions of DLCC

- 1. Ensure coordinated action by different departments of the Government to prevent killing /injuring/ illegal capturing of wild animals by snaring, use of explosives, poisoning, electrocution, etc. in areas outside forests, and if requested so by the Wildlife Warden, in forest areas also.
- 2. Ensure coordinated action by different Departments for expeditious payment of ex-gratia to persons affected by Human Wildlife Conflict
- 3. Seek assistance of Wildlife Crime Control Bureau (WCCB) or other expert organizations in capacity building for intelligence gathering, investigation and prosecution for prevention and dealing with wildlife crime.

The District Level Coordination Committee (DLCC) shall meet as often as required but no later than three months of the last meeting.
