ORDER

As per Government Order read as paper 1st above, Administrative Sanction was accorded for an amount of Rs.3641.81 lakh for the project 'Construction of 200 bedded Cardiology Block at Government Medical College, Kottayam' under Tranche XXVI of NABARD RIDF scheme (NABARD share Rs.3095.56 lakh, State share

546.28 lakh). As per Government Order read as paper 2nd above, M/s. HITES was entrusted as the SPV for the project. As per Government Order read as paper 3rd above, Technical Sanction was issued for the above project for an amount of Rs.3025.66386 lakh.

The Director of Medical Education (DME) as per letter read as 5th paper above submitted the Reimbursement Claim for the cost of work done in the month of November 2024 (RAB 20), in respect of project Construction of 200 Bedded Cardiology Block at Government Medical College, Kottayam and requested to release the reimbursement claimed (Rs.2,12,40,854/-).

3. Government have examined the matter in detail and are pleased to release an amount of **Rs.2,12,41,000/- (Rupees Two Crore Twelve Lakh and Forty One Thousand only)** to the Director of Medical Education on account of Reimbursement Claim of the cost of work done in the month of November 2024 (RAB 20), for the project 'Construction of 200 Bedded Cardiology Block at Government Medical College, Kottayam' assisted by NABARD under RIDF XXVI from the head of account '**4210-03-105-12(01)-PV - Infrastructure Projects Under NABARD**'. The amount for the purpose has been additionally authorized as per Government Order read as 6th paper above.

4. The Director of Medical Education shall take timely steps to regularize this additional expenditure through Re-appropriation of Savings only within the Grant/Supplementary Demands for Grants before the close of the current financial year.
