Fisheries Department- Construction of Fish Net Factory at Neendakara, in Kollam District- Administrative Sanction accorded- Orders issued.

### ORDER

In the budget speech 2024, an amount of Rs.5 crore was allocated for the net factory at Neendakarad in Kollam district . Based on this, the Director of Fisheries as per the letter read above furnished a detailed proposal for the construction of "MATSYAFED NET FACTORY AT NEENDAKARA IN KOLLAM" for an amount of Rs.53 core and has requested to accord Sanction for the same.

2) Government have examined the matter in detail and are pleased to accord Administrative Sanction for setting up of "MATSYAFED NET FACTORY AT NEENDAKARA IN KOLLAM" for an amount of Rs. 5300 laks under the Head Of Account 4405-00-103-87 (P) .The Director of Fisheries should note the following observations on perusal of the estimate for "Buildings and other Infrastructure components of the said project.

a) The foundation of the building is proposed with RCC piles of 400mm diameter to a depth of 15m and mat foundation of 20cm thick is provided to cover full GF area over the pile cap.

Hence the necessity of the mat foundation in the portion which is not subjected to machine loading may be reviewed and provision for mat foundation may be

restricted to machine loading portion only considering economy in construction.

b) A lump sum amount of Rs. 29.50 lakhs and Rs. 27.00 lakhs are provided for Miscellaneous & Contingencies and Lump sum respectively in the estimate, which seems on higher side and may be deleted while according Technical Sanction by competent authority.

c) Store Purchase rules shall be strictly adhered for any purchase related to Mechanical/Electrical works.

d) The MATSYAFED authorities shall ensure that final treated effluents are disposed off in confirmation of KSPCB norms ( with the permissible limits / safe limits ) and the possibility for the reuse of the treated water may also be explored.
