### ORDER

The system of Integrated Financial Adviser (IFA) has significant potential to enhance the efficiency and accountability of the Government operations. It is also a solution to streamline financial decision making.

In order to realize this potential, Government are pleased to constitute a Committee with the following members to implement the Integrated Financial Adviser (IFA) system :

1. Additional Chief Secretary (Finance) - Chairman
2. All other Additional Chief Secretaries - Members
3. Officer on Special Duty(Finance) - Member Secretary

The following are the Terms of Reference of the Committee .

- i. To formulate a draft implementation framework for the IFA system in Kerala, including structure, reporting relationships and cadre arrangements.
- ii. To recommend the list of functions presently under Finance Department that may be delegated to the IFA within Administrative Departments, while identifying those which must continue to be referred to the Finance Department.
- iii. To propose modalities for integrating the IFA system with existing procedures including Working Group approvals, budget execution, and financial audits, in compliance with applicable financial codes and manuals.

The Committee should examine the model and give recommendations

within a month.
