**ORDER**

In the WP(C) 24195/2020 filed by Shri. Anil Akkara, former MLA, Wadakkanchery before the Hon'ble High Court, with prayer for the timely completion of Wadakkanchery flat complex, under LIFE Mission, the Hon'ble Court has directed the Chief Executive Officer , LIFE Mission, to obtain a report on the structural stability of the housing complex through the technical wing of National Institute of Technology (NIT) Calicut. The structural stability assessment conducted by the technical wing of NIT Calicut recommended that it is possible to take up the construction further.

2. As per the Interim Order of the Hon'ble High Court read as 1<sup>st</sup> paper above, the Director, NIT Calicut has been directed to constitute

an expert committee for submitting a detailed rehabilitation/retrofitting plan based on the structural stability report within four weeks.

3. As per the letter read above, the Director, NIT Calicut has informed that an expert committee under the chairmanship of Dr Sajith AS (Professor, Department of Civil Engineering) of the Institute has been constituted for the purpose and submitted the following facts for consideration:

- For the preparation of a detailed rehabilitation plan at least one additional site visit is required, the stipulated period of four weeks is insufficient to submit a comprehensive report. Hence it is requested for an extended time, a minimum period of two months for submitting the detailed plan.
- The estimated total expenses including the professional charge for undertaking the mentioned work would be ₹ 5,00,000/- plus GST, amounting to a total of ₹. 5,90,000/- (Five Lakhs and Ninety Thousand only).

4. Government have examined the matter in detail and are pleased to accord sanction for the release of ₹5,90,000 (Rupees Five Lakhs and Ninety Thousand only) to NIT Calicut, from the Head of Account 4217-60-051-95 (P) before 31.03.2026 to meet the total expenses including the professional charge for preparing the rehabilitation/retrofitting plan.

5) The Chief Executive Officer, LIFE Mission shall provide all necessary assistance for the expert committee including the manpower for site clearance and other support required at the site so that the expert committee could submit the report within the stipulated time.
