### ORDER

As per the G.O read as 1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> paper above, Administrative Sanction was issued for the procurement of equipment for the Centre of Excellence to Trauma & Burns unit Govt. Medical College, Thiruvananthapuram under "National Programme for Prevention and

Management of Trauma and Burn Injuries (NPPMT & BI)". The Government of India had sanctioned grant in-aid (non-recurring) of ₹80,00,000/- (Rupees Eighty lakh only) for strengthening of Trauma & Burn Management Services under the Centre of Excellence (CoE) established as a part of the above project.

2) As per the letter read as 4<sup>th</sup> paper above, the Director of Medical Education has submitted a proposal for according of Administrative Sanction to procure the equipment under the Centre of Excellence (CoE) - NPPMT&BI fund.

3) Government have examined the matter in detail and are pleased to accord Administrative Sanction for an amount of Rs.80,00,000/- (Rupees Eighty Lakh Only) for the procurement of items utilizing the grant in aid sanctioned and allotted for Centre of Excellence (CoE) established as a part of National Programme for Prevention and Management of Trauma & Burn Injuries (NPPMT&BI) at Govt.Medical College, Thiruvananthapuram, as per the following;
