The Director of Tourism as per the letter read above had submitted a proposal "AI-Powered Automated DPR Processing Solution for Kerala Department of Tourism" for an amount of ₹ 19,95,000/- (Rupees Nineteen Lakh Ninety Five Thousand only) under the Head of Account 5452-01-101- 99-00-34-03- Upgradation, Creation of Infrastructure and Amenities (Plan) before the Departmental Working Group . The working group meeting held on 19.02.2026 approved the proposal subject to certain conditions.

2. Government have examined the project proposal in detail and are pleased to accord Administrative Sanction for the project "**AI-Powered**

**Automated DPR Processing Solution"** for an amount of Rs. 19,95,000/- (Rupees Nineteen Lakh Ninety Five Thousand only) under the Head of Account 5452-01-101-99-00-34-03- Upgradation , Creation of infrastructure and amenities subject to the following conditions;

- i. The solution shall mandatory provide API integration with the e-Office system, PRICE software, E-tender and DPR modules.
- ii. The Director of Tourism shall ensure that necessary API sharing consent is obtained from the respective application owners.
- iii. The payment shall be released strictly based on the approved deliverables and milestones achieved.
- iv. The complete source code, including all custom developments, APIs, documentation and related intellectual property shall be vested with Department of Tourism.
- v. The proposal shall be submitted to the Technical Advisory Committee (TAC) for vetting.
- vi. The product should be ready to use (deployment- ready) condition, by the start-up . This shall be verified and confirmed by KSUM.

3.The Director of Tourism shall ensure that all the procedural and codal formalities are strictly adhered to.
