ORDER

As per Government Order read as 1st paper, 5 managerial posts on temporary basis were created in Kerala Road Safety Authority and as per the Government order read as 2nd & 3rd papers, 5 incumbents were appointed in the posts for a period of three years on contract basis.

2) Among them, Smt.Kala.P. (Director, Road User Safety) and Shri.NijuAzhakesan (Director, Data Analysis & Performance Monitoring) are continuing in KRSA and the continuance sanction of the posts and period of contract of the above officers had been extended up to 31.12.2025, as per order read as 4th paper.

3) As per the letter read as 5th paper, The Commissioner, Kerala Road Safety has submitted a proposal to extend the period of the managerial posts and the term of contract of the two officers for a further period of one year with effect from 01.01.2026 as per the terms and conditions of contract appointment.

4) Government have examined the matter in detail and are pleased to accord continuance sanction for the two managerial posts (Director I -Data Analysis & Performance Monitoring and Director II-Road User Safety) in the Kerala Road Safety Authority for a period of one year from 01.01.2026. Sanction is also accorded for extending the contract appointment of Sri. Niju Azhakesan, Director I , Data Analysis & Performance Monitoring and Smt. Kala P, Director II, Road User Safety for a further period of one year with effect from 03.01.2026(01.01.2026 mandatory break, 02.01.2026 holiday), subject to the condition that the employees have no claim for regularization in the respective posts.

5) The Road Safety Commissioner shall include this clause in the contract agreement and assess the performance of the two officers and also review their performance on monthly basis.
