ORDER

As per the letter read as 1st paper above, the District Collector, Ernakulam, submitted a proposal for undertaking flood-resilient critical infrastructure projects in Ernakulam City. The proposal pertains to mitigation works associated with the Mullassery Canal, wherein critical utility infrastructures such as power lines, water supply systems, sewerage networks, and telecommunications facilities are presently obstructing the natural flow of the canal, thereby exacerbating the risk of urban flooding in Kochi City. The District Disaster Management Authority (DDMA), Ernakulam reported that the proposed works are critical for enhancing urban flood resilience, particularly in view of the

ensuing monsoon season. The consolidated proposal comprises the following components:

- KSEB: Realignment of HT/LT lines and shifting of transformer stations to Ring Main Units (RMUs) – ₹41,16,001/-
- KWA: Replacement of 900 mm CI pipes with HDPE pipelines across MG Road, shifting of potable water lines, and rectification of damaged sewerage lines and manholes – ₹91,04,040/-
- BSNL: Shifting of 96F Optical Fiber Cables and dismantling of underground cables obstructing the canal – ₹3,40,860/-
- Total Project Cost: ₹1,35,60,901/-

2. The matter was placed in the State Executive Committee meeting held on 22.04.2026 and the committee recommended the proposal for Flood Resilient Critical Infrastructure Projects in Ernakulam City- Operation Breakthrough - associated with the Mullassery Canal which costs ₹1,35,60,901/- .

3. The Government have examined the matter in detail and are pleased to sanction an amount of ₹1,35,60,901/- (Rupees One Crore Thirty Five Lakh Sixty Thousand Nine Hundred and One Only) from the Head of Account **2245-07-101-99 Structural Mitigation Measures** for the mitigation work including utility shifting of infrastructures such as power lines, water supply systems, sewerage networks, and telecommunications facilities by which the flow of the Mullassery Canal is obstructed and thereby exacerbating urban flooding in Kochi City, to DC, Ernakulam.

4. The amount shall be utilized from the current year's Budget Provision.
