### **ORDER**

As per the Government Order read as 2nd paper above, an amount of Rs. 120 Crore available in the SDRF was released to the Member Secretary, KSDMA for taking up activities related to relief, recovery and rehabilitation of families affected by the Meppadi landslide, in relaxation of SDRF/NDRF norms ordered as per the judgement read as 1st paper above.

2) As per G.O read as 4th paper above, Government have accorded Administrative Sanction for the reconstruction of the following 7 stretches of roads which were severely damaged during the Meppadi landslide, at a total cost of Rs. 15 Crore.

1. Chooralmala - Mundakkai Road
2. Mundakkai - Punchirimattom Road
3. Chooralmala HS - Padavettikunnu Road
4. Chooralmala New Village Office - Dam Site Road
5. New Village Office - Gopimoola Road
6. Punchirimattam - Vanarani Road
7. GLPS - 8th No. Road

3) As per the G.O read as 4th paper above, permission was also granted to the Member Secretary, KSDMA to release an amount of Rs.15 Crore to the bank account of Chief Engineer, PWD (Roads) from the fund released as per Government Order read as 2nd paper above. It was also ordered that the Public Works Department (PWD) shall be the implementing agency and the authority to issue Technical Sanction for the works. It was further ordered that the amount shall be released to the Bank Account of PWD by the Member Secretary, KSDMA after the issuance of Technical Sanction.

4) As per paper read as 6th paper above, Technical Sanction was issued for an amount of Rs.15 Crore for the work- *General-SDRF 2024-Reconstruction of various roads damaged during Meppadi Landslide under Meppadi Grama Panchayath in Wayanad district-7 roads stretches- Civil work- General Civil Work* from the source of fund H/A 2245-02-101-94-01-00-00-N-V-|Flood Other Items.

5) As per G.O read as 5th paper above, Government have recouped the balance amount of Rs.116.15 Crore(Rs.120 Crore- Rs.3.85 Crore) available with the Member Secretary, KSDMA to the Head of Account 2245-02-101-94-01-Flood Other Items.

6) As the Technical Sanction for the above mentioned works has been issued by the Chief Engineer (Roads), Public Works Department, Government are pleased to sanction an amount of Rs.15 Crore (Rupees Fifteen Crore only) to the Executive Engineer (Roads Division), Public Works Department, Wayanad district for the reconstruction of the 7 road stretches mentioned in para 2 above . The amount of Rs.15 Crores ( Rupees Fifteen Crores only) shall be credited to the **STSB Account No.718011400000223** in the District Treasury, Wayanad of the

Executive Engineer, PWD Roads Division, Kalpetta, Wayanad from the SDRF under the Head of Account **2245-02-101-94-01-Flood Other Items.**

7) The Finance Officer, Disaster Management Department shall monitor the process of release and utilization of the fund sanctioned.
