## **ORDER**

The Director of Fisheries, as per the letter read above, has furnished the proposal for the 'Development of Ornamental Fisheries 2025-26' for an amount of Rs. 100 lakh under the Head of Account 2405-00-190-95 for considering in the Departmental Working Group 2025-26 and has requested to issue administrative sanction for the same.

- (2) The objectives of the scheme are as follows:-
- To promote the production of high-quality ornamental fish for both domestic and export markets.
- To enhance fish seed production using imported or superior brood stock to ensure sustainability and quality.
- To expand the production and marketing of aquatic plants to support ornamental fish ecosystems.
- To manufacture and sell aquaria, catering to hobbyists and the ornamental fish trade.
- To develop strong domestic marketing channels, including retail outlets, weekly buyer seller meets and annual trade shows, offering ornamental fish seeds, aquatic plants, fish feed, aquaria and accessories.
- To facilitate the export of ornamental fish, tapping into international markets to boost revenue.
- To prioritize capacity-building and skill development for farmers, stakeholders, entrepreneurs, KAVIL staff and interns.
- To support local producers by purchasing ornamental fish from

homestead units to strengthen domestic and export marketing.

• To utilise aqua hub facilities to provide infrastructure and support for ornamental fish breeders, covering production, collection, conditioning, packing and marketing.

- To implement targeted market promotion strategies and establish strong market linkages to ensure sustained growth and market presence for ornamental fish products.
- (3) The financial details of the project are as follows:
