**ORDER**

The Government has granted in-principle approval for the organization of the 'Kerala-European Union Conclave on Blue Economy, Industrial Clusters, Skill Development, Education, and Migration'. This conclave, led by the Fisheries Department with the active support of the Industries Department and the Kerala State Industrial Development Corporation (KSIDC), will be held at the Leela Hotel, Kovalam.

2. The Ambassador of the European Union to India, as per the letter read as above, formally requested the nomination of a multi-department nodal team and the appointment of a nodal officer to ensure effective coordination with the European Union team.

3. In the above context, the following is ordered for the preparation and organization of the Kerala-European Union Blue Economy Conclave scheduled on September 18-19, 2025.

4. In response to the request and to ensure comprehensive preparation and organization, a multi-department nodal team has been constituted to liaise with the European Union team. The following departments are included:

5. Each of the aforementioned departments shall appoint their respective nodal officers.

6. Fisheries Director Smt. Chelsasini V. IAS is appointed as the Chief Nodal Officer for the Kerala-European Union Conclave.

7. The Additional Skill Acquisition Programme (ASAP) is assigned the responsibility of coordinating the projects in education, training, and skill development sectors.

8. The Fisheries Director is entrusted with the responsibility of engaging a Government-approved agency of international standards for the professional preparation and presentation of all conclave-related projects.

9. The General Administration Department (Protocol) and the Resident Commissioner Delhi at Kerala House shall coordinate with the Ministry of External Affairs to obtain necessary approvals and permissions.
