ORDER

As per the letter read as 1st paper above, the Ministry of Finance, Government of India had sanctioned and released an amount of Rs.529.50 crore as additional allocation on account of Natural Disaster under Part I of of the Scheme for Special Assistance to States for Capital Expenditure 2024-25 for the State of Kerala and an amount of Rs. 12 crore had been earmarked in the SASCI 2024-25 project for the construction of three school buildings—GVHSS Vellarmala, GLPS Mundakkai, and the HS Section of GVHSS. As per third paper read above administrative sanction of Rs. 4 Crore was already issued for the construction of GLPS Mundakkai. Administrative sanction of Rs. 8

Crore for GVHSS Vellarmala and the HS Section of GVHSS has not been issued.

As per the letter read as 2nd and 4th paper above, the Chief Engineer, Public Works Department (Buildings) submitted revised estimate for GVHSS Vellarmala amounting to **Rs. 7.5 Crore** and the HS Section of GVHSS, amounting to **Rs. 11.5 crore**, as such for a total amount of Rs. 19 Crore (11.5 + 7.5). Out of a total project cost of **Rs. 19 Crore**, Rs. 8 Crore has already been approved while the remaining 11 crore has to be raised.

Government have examined the matter in detail and are pleased to accord Administrative Sanction for the work of construction of GVHSS Vellarmala and the HS Section of GVHSS for an amount of Rs. 13.34 Crore (Rupees Thirteen Crore Thirty Four Lakh only), out of which Rs. 8 Crore was already sanctioned under SASCI, and **Rs. 5.34 Crore** as additional assistance from SASCI, in anticipation of sanction from Government of India.

As per the fund flow stipulated in the Government Order read as fifth paper above, the Finance Officer, Disaster Management Department, shall take urgent action to transfer the above amount to the vendor account of the Public Works Department, Buildings Division.

The Public Works Department (Buildings) shall, in turn, submit the Utilization Certificate to the Disaster Management Department, within the stipulated time.
