ORDER

As per the letter read as 1st paper above, the Ministry of Finance, Government of India had sanctioned and released an amount of Rs.529.50 crore as additional allocation on account of Natural Disaster under Part I of of the Scheme for Special Assistance to States for Capital Expenditure 2024-25 for the State of Kerala.

As per the 2nd paper read above, the District Collector, Wayanad has submitted a report of the pending bills of ongoing projects of capital nature, in Wayanad district, amounting to Rs.1,86,00,154/- of Public Works Department (Roads), Rs.44,01,366/- of National Health Mission and Rs.3,59,84,355/- of works done by Nirmithi Kendra.

As per Letter No. 44(1)/PF-S/2025-26 (CAPEX) dated 07/04/2025, from the Ministry of Finance the condition No. 2 states that

"Funds provided to the State Government/UT Administration under the scheme by the GOI may be used by the State Government for both new and

ongoing capital projects, for long term benefit to the State. The funds may also be used for settling pending bills in ongoing capital projects".

Government have examined the matter in detail and are pleased to accord Administrative Sanction for the pending bills of ongoing projects in Wayanad for an amount of Rs. 5.83 Crore (Rs Five Crore and Eighty Three Lakh only) under SASCI, subject to the approval of Government of India.

As per the fund flow stipulated in the Government Order read as 3rd paper above, the Finance Officer, Disaster Management Department, shall take urgent action to transfer the above amount to the vendor account of the District Collector, Wayanad/ Concerned Implementing Agencies.

The District Collector, Wayanad/ Concerned Implementing Agencies shall, in turn, submit the Utilization Certificate to the Disaster Management Department, within the stipulated time.
