- Please ensure that candidate names and passport photocopies are submitted at least 60 days in advance. This allows the Indian Council for Training & Social Research (ICTSR) to make necessary arrangements for travel, accommodations, faculty booking, visa processing, and program planning.
- For accompanying spouse and/or children (aged 5 to 12 and above), the estimated charges for the entire duration will be INR 5,69,000 plus 18% GST. Payment should be made in advance to ICTSR.
- Nominations will be accepted based on seat availability and receipt of the participation fee by the specified deadline.
- Please be aware that ICTSR will not provide accommodations before or after the designated program dates. Participants needing extended stays must arrange accommodations independently.
- The participation fee is non-refundable. However, substitutions can be made or fees adjusted for future nominations.
- Due to limited seats, it is advisable to submit nominations using the attached format as soon as possible to ensure availability. Nominations will be accepted based on seat availability and timely payment.
