The following draft rules further to amend the Kerala Motor Vehicles Rules, 1989, which the Government of Kerala propose to make in exercise of the powers conferred by sub-section (3) of section 213 of the Motor Vehicles Act, 1988 (Central Act 59 of 1988), is hereby published for general information as required by sub-section (1) of section 212 of the said Act.

Notice is hereby given that the said draft will be taken up for consideration on or after thirty days from the date of publication of this notification in the Gazette and that objections or suggestions, if any, that may be received from any person in respect of the draft rules on or before the period



specified above will be considered by the Government. Objections or suggestions, if any in duplicate, shall be addressed to the Secretary to Government, Transport Department, Government Secretariat, Thiruvananthapuram.

#### DRAFT RULES

- 1. Short title and commencement.- (1) These rules may be called the Kerala Motor Vehicles (... Amendment) Rules, 2023.
  - (2) They shall come in to force at once.
- 2. Amendment of the Rules.- In the Kerala Motor Vehicles Rules, 1989, in rule 406, in serial No.4. Assistant Motor Vehicle Inspectors, in item (i), for the words, letters and symbols "Badge with the letters 'KMV' and Kerala Emblem" the words, letters and symbols "crest in a monogram with letters 'KMV' on its centre surrounded by wreath and Ashoka Emblem on its top" shall be substituted.
